The ideal applicant should have:

- degree in Law, Public Administration, Political Science, or a related field
- eight years of related experience, including experience in negotiations, leading teams, and policy development in both the private and public sectors
- an understanding of the Gwich'in history, cultural, and political environment would be an asset
