

CALL FOR MEMBERS

Legal Services Board of Nunavut

The Minister of Justice has an upcoming opening for a member-at-large to serve on the Legal Services Board of Nunavut (LSB).

The candidate should be an individual who is a respected member of their community that has experience in dealing with justice and social issues. LSB members are required to attend a minimum of three (3) in-person Board meetings annually. Attendance at up to two (2) additional teleconference Board meetings may be required. A number of Board members may be selected to serve on the Executive Committee. Executive members can expect to attend an additional six (6) teleconferences a year. Honoraria for meetings is provided.

The LSB is mandated to ensure the provision of legal aid services to all eligible persons. The Board administers the *Legal Services Act* and regulations. The Board reviews legal services provided in the territory and the performance of the regional committees. Members can expect to coordinate the provision of legal services and publish details of the services available to Nunavummiut.
