

Robin Joseph Imbeault

December 25, 1943 – November 09, 2011

After spending his final days surrounded by his family, Bentley, Alberta resident Mr. Robin Imbeault passed away in Lacombe hospital after a lengthy but courageous battle with cancer.

Robin was born and raised in Val D'or, Quebec where he met his wife Mary in 1965. They married in 1966 and started their family with the birth of their son Robby in 1967, followed by their daughter Sonya in 1968. In 1976 they moved to Uranium City, Saskatchewan where Robin worked at Eldorado Mine until it closed in 1981. Robin then accepted a job with Giant (Royal Oak) Mine in Yellowknife, Northwest Territories. He worked for Royal Oak for the next 13 years in Yellowknife and also spent some time at their Hope Brook Mine in Newfoundland. In 1994 he and Mary moved to Edson, Alberta where Robin was employed with Columbia Industries until he retired in 2010. That fall, Robin and Mary moved to Bentley to be closer to their family in southern Alberta.

Robin's greatest passion in life, aside from his family, was his love of travel and riding his motorbike. This was a hobby he shared with Mary, and they enjoyed many hours together on the road. Each mile that they traveled was a special moment that they shared, and is now a precious memory that will be treasured.



Robin was predeceased by his father Adelard Imbeault, his brother Roger Imbeault and his sister Lily Demers.

Left to cherish his memory are his loving wife Mary Imbeault, his children; Robby Imbeault (Sylvia) and Sonya Imbeault (Gord), his grandchildren; Patrick, Robin (Amani), Shayna and Lisa, and his great-granddaughters Aleena and Leila.
