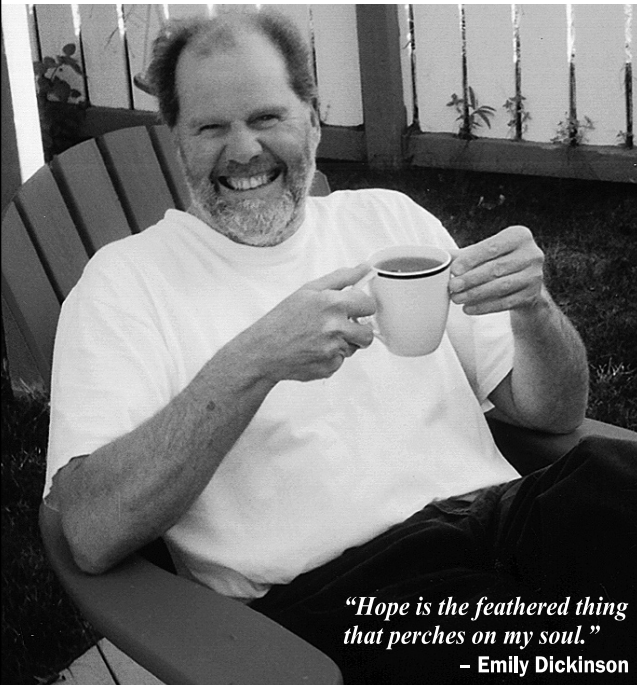


# IN MEMORY OF **DON JOSSA**
