The AAROM Guardian Technician will provide technical research and support in the operation of the Dehcho Aboriginal Aquatic Resources and Ocean Management program (AAROM), the Aboriginal Fishery Strategy program (AFS), and the Dehcho K'ehodi program. This DFO funded program promotes greater Indigenous engagement in fisheries and aquatic related research, planning and decision making processes. The AAROM Guardian Technician will report to the Dehcho AAROM Coordinator and be guided by Indigenous community concerns on fisheries and aquatic issues. AAROM is a Community Based Monitoring (CBM) program.

- self-motivated with solid research and analytical skills
- strong communication and writing skills
- comfortable using computer software including MS Word, Excel and PowerPoint
